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We would like to confirm that VCC © is engaged in developing vocational education in a modern form which allows employees to acquire key market-oriented skills as part of their non-formal education.

The VCC © Foundation's monitoring as well as labour market and education research are ongoing. The organisation applies analysis of European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (CEDEFOP) and cooperates with Partners and vocational experts in EU member and non-member states. This collaboration has resulted in developing a comprehensive education offer meeting current needs expressed by European citizens and based on Lifelong Learning programme.

The aim of the VCC© certification system is to provide employers with reliable and comprehensive information on qualifications that (prospective) employees hold.

The VCC© System is characterised by the following:

- Connections with the European Qualification Framework being a point of reference in terms of adaptation and integration with national qualification systems applied in EU member states.
- Defined, described, and widely available procedures for supervising quality at each stage of developing teaching materials, accrediting Partners, and delivering training courses by validating, examining, and issuing certificates.
- Quality management system implemented in accordance with ISO 9001:2009 and ISO 29990:2010 standards.
- Being based on sets of competences whose acquisition within the VCC© system meets learning effects standards, i.e. knowledge, skills, and social competences gained in the education process. Detailed information on the acquired result is provided in supplement to VCC© certificate,
- Opportunity to gain validated qualifications for pre-defined sets of competences by carrying out a formal examination process which, if passed, is confirmed with VCC© certificate. Certification is separate from the teaching process and it is managed via an innovative electronic platform.
- Being recognised for dedicated market qualifications and acknowledged by business organisations, employer associations, as well as public institutions - both local and central ones. The VCC© is recognised and acknowledged also by higher education institutions, entities functioning within formal education sector, as well as entities dealing with vocational development and development of entrepreneurs.
- VCC© foundation issues VCC© certificates within international non-government organisation.
